

10 Key Principles Anti-Bullying Charter

Everyone in our school agree to the following actions to make sure that bullying does not happen at Wootton Community Primary School.



Our school:

1. Listens All children and parents and carers are listened to and work together to prevent, report and respond to incidents of bullying.
2. Includes us all - All children, whoever they are, are included, valued and take part fully in all aspects of school life.
3. Respects - All school staff are role models to others showing how we should all treat each other.
4. Challenges - All forms of inappropriate language and behaviour is challenged and taken seriously.
5. Celebrates difference - Difference is actively and visibly celebrated and welcome across the whole school both inside and outside of the classroom.
6. Understands - All school staff, children and parents and carers understand what bullying is and what it isn't.
7. Believes - All children and their parents and carers are acknowledged, believed and taken seriously when reporting incidents of bullying.
8. Reports bullying - All children within the school and their parents and carers understand how to report incidents of bullying and can name someone in school to talk to.
9. Takes action - We respond quickly to all incidents of bullying. Children are involved in implementing the school values and rules and agree to follow the 'Good to be Green' system. School Council represent the 'voice' of the school with regular meetings and discussions with the Headteacher.
10. Has clear policies - our school's anti-bullying policy supports our charter and this is embedded within other school policies.
