



Anti-Bullying Charter

Everyone in our school agrees to the following charter so that we work together in the prevention and management of bullying, making sure that everyone understands that **Bullying is not allowed** in our school. At Wootton Primary School we understand bullying as:

‘Someone who who makes us feel frightened or unhappy by hurting us or our feelings Several Times On Purpose’ (STOP)

To keep our school a safe and happy place we will:

1. **Listen** – Make sure that all children and parents/carers are listened to.
2. **Include us all** - All children, whoever they are, are included, valued and take part fully in all aspects of school life.
3. **Respect** – Make sure that everyone is treated the same, respecting all our differences and treated with dignity.
4. **Challenge** - All forms of inappropriate language and behaviour is questioned and challenged and taken seriously.
5. **Understand** - All school staff, children and parents/carers understand what bullying is and what it isn't.
6. **Believe** - All children and their parents/carers are listened to, believed and taken seriously when reporting incidents of bullying.
7. **Report bullying** - All children within the school and their parents/carers understand how to report incidents of bullying (things done several times on purpose) and can name someone in school to talk to.
8. **Take action** - Respond quickly to all incidents of bullying. We will work hard to keep the school values and rules using the ‘Good to be Green’ system. School Council will represent the ‘voice’ of the school with regular meetings and discussions with the Headteacher.
9. **Take responsibility** – Think before we say or do anything; use kind words, kind hands and kind feet and cheer people up if they are upset or lonely.
