

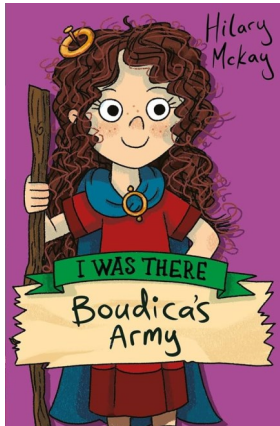

Year Three Overview Summer 2

English

This half term we will be reading *I was there; Boudicca's army*. The children will use this text to support their writing focuses and final history unit—Roman Britain.

We will explore what life was like before and during the Roman occupation and use the writing stimulus to create character descriptions, character dialog, a non-chronological report and a narrative. The children will also learn how to use direct speech, complex sentences, apostrophes and a range of sentence starters to improve their writing.



Maths

This half term we will recap the key mathematical concepts and learning objectives in the national curriculum.

- Identify the value of each digit in a given number
- Order and compare given numbers to 1000
- Write numbers to 1000 in numerals and words
- Add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers with up to one exchange
- Use a range of methods to solve addition and subtraction problems
- Use known addition and subtraction facts to solve money related problems
- Know 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times tables and related division facts
- Order and compare unit and non unit fractions with the same denominator
- Add and subtract unit and non unit fractions with the same denominator.

Science

In science this half term we will be recapping all 5 science modules studied this year

- Animals including humans
- Plants
- Light
- Magnets and forces
- Rocks

The children will have the opportunity to refine and develop their scientific knowledge and explore, through problem solving, key scientific concepts in the national curriculum.

PSHE

Our topic in PSHE will be 'Healthy Relationships and Growing and Changing'. The class will look at and discuss; Recognising emotions, Physical and emotional changes during growing up and helping to understand identity.

Computing

This half term the children will build upon their ability to type. This children will explore both Microsoft Word and Google Docs. They will become familiar with both operating systems and learn how to create and write a history themed non-chron using their preferred application.

History

This half term will focus on the roman conquest and occupation of Britain. This unit will allow the children the opportunity to recap the previous two history topics the stone ages (life before the romans) and the rise and fall of the roman empire. During this unit, the children will learn how life in Britain was changed by the romans, learn who Boudicca was and what she did and explore what lasting legacy the romans had on our country .

DT

During this unit the children will design, create and evaluate two roman inspired creations—a roman shield and miniature catapult. The children will use a range of materials including cardboard, paper mache, paint, wood and rubber bands to plan, do and review their projects.



French

In French we are going to look at famous landmarks from around the world. We will then move onto learning how to ask and answer questions in French.

RE

In RE we will be exploring the idea of identity. We will begin looking at our own individual identities, before moving on and linking in to the Jewish story of Esther.

Music

In music we will be using charanga to develop their understanding of notation and following along with written music. The children will also help select their own music for the end of year performance.

PE

For this summer term, the children will take part in athletics during their PE lessons. They will learn techniques for running long and short distances, throwing skills for javelin and long jump.
